

# Department of Electronic Engineering, Asia Eastern University of Science and Technology Enforcement Rules for Professional Technical Ability Graduation Threshold

Passed in the first academic affairs meeting of the 2013 academic year on September 25, 2013

Passed in the second academic affairs meeting of the 2012 academic year on December 12, 2012

Passed in the second academic affairs meeting of the 2010 academic year on November 9, 2010

Passed in the fourth academic affairs meeting of the 2009 academic year on February 2, 2010

Article 1 The Department of Electronic Engineering (hereinafter referred to as “the Department”) has established the "Enforcement Rules for Professional Technical Ability Graduation Threshold of the Department of Electronic Engineering, Oriental Institute of Technology" (hereinafter referred to as “the Enforcement Rules”) in accordance with the "Graduation Threshold Guidelines" of the University.

Article 2 These rules apply to day-time students of the department enrolled after the 2013 academic year (inclusive) of the University.

Article 3 Students should pass at least one of the department's professional technical ability indicators before graduation (those obtained before enrollment will not be counted); passing is deemed as having passed the "professional technical ability" graduation threshold. The student professional technical ability indicators mentioned in “Enforcement Rules” cover the following items related to electronics, electrical machinery, and information:

- I. Obtaining a B-level technician or professional license from a government agency.
- II. Obtaining a professional license equivalent to B level from a non-governmental organization.
- III. Publishing conference or journal papers.
- IV. Publishing articles in relevant professional journals in Taiwan or abroad.
- V. Being approved for patents.
- VI. Having awards from professional competitions inside or outside the school, which must be “Excellence” (inclusive) or above.
- VII. Participating in the department's off-campus internship course for 160 hours; participating in the whole process and having passing grades.
- VIII. Passing the national examination.
- IX. Being admitted to a research institute approved by the Ministry of Education.

Explanations of the aforementioned professional technical ability indicators is provided by the department's course committee.

Article 4 Article 3, Paragraphs 3 to 7 of the Enforcement Rules are limited to the top two students in order.

Article 5 When students obtain "student professional technical ability indicators" mentioned in Article 3 of these Enforcement Rules, they can log in online during the 17th and 18th weeks of each semester (the next semester of the fourth year of studies is in the 12th and 13th weeks), print out the

application form, and attach a copy of the supporting documents or transcripts (bring the original copies when applying for inspection by the reviewer) and send it to the department for review.

Article 6 If you fail to pass the "student professional technical ability indicators" review before graduation, you must participate in the "Professional Ability" related remedial plan arranged by the department.

Article 7 The Enforcement Rules have been implemented and announced after approval during an Academic Affairs Meeting; the same shall apply to all subsequent amendments thereto.
